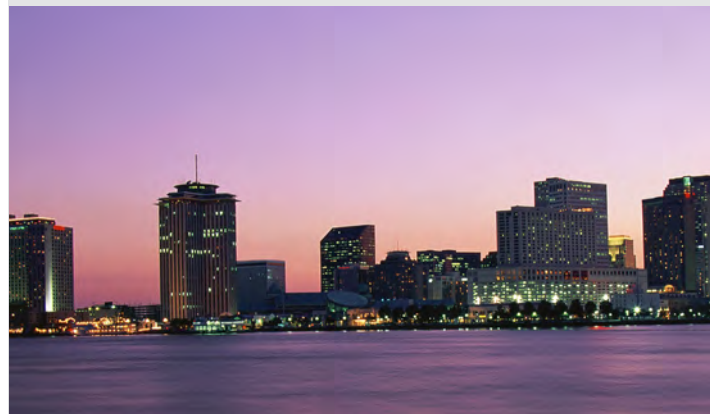
THE SOUTHERN HEADACHE SOCIETY
